LETTER ORDER

To Counsel of Record: *Bullseyebore, Inc. v. Landbase Trading Co., Ltd. et al.*

Dear Counsel:

This Letter Order confirms that **the Court** has cancelled the March 25, 2024 motions hearing and **has RESCHEDULED the hearing for Monday, April 8, 2024 at 2:30 PM.** As previously indicated, the Court will hear argument on Plaintiff's requested preliminary injunction, and Defendants and/or any other affected persons may challenge the appropriateness of this Court's Order (ECF No. 26) granting Plaintiff's Second Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and move to dissolve the same. (ECF No. 27.) In addition, the Court will hear argument on the pending¹ Motion to Dismiss (ECF No. 31) for lack of personal jurisdiction filed on behalf of several of the website Defendants in this matter.²

As discussed with the parties, **the Court INSTRUCTS the parties to follow the below expedited schedule for briefing on the Motion to Dismiss (ECF No. 31):**
